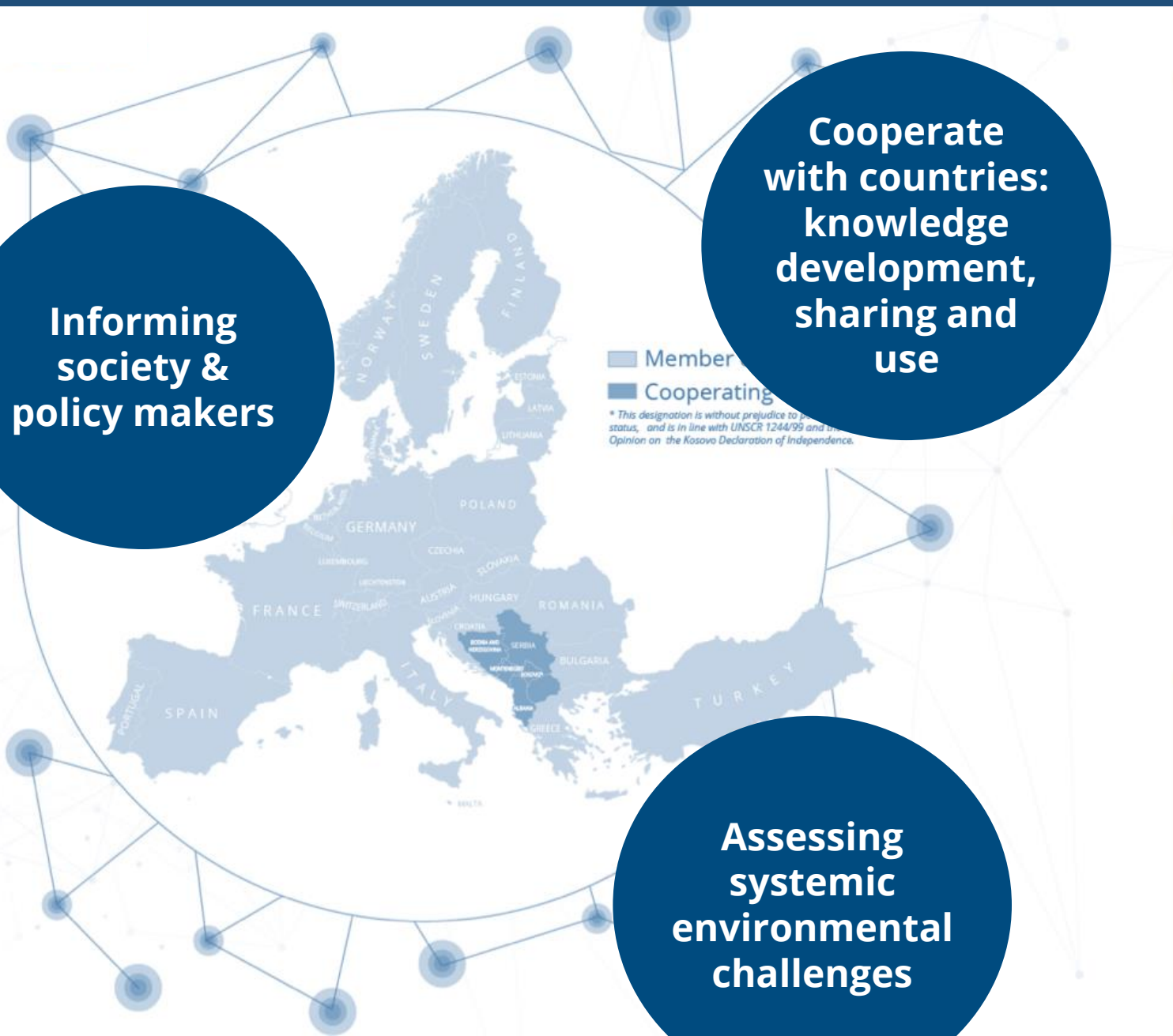

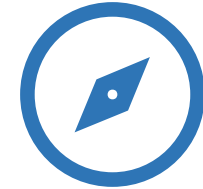

But not an isolated one!

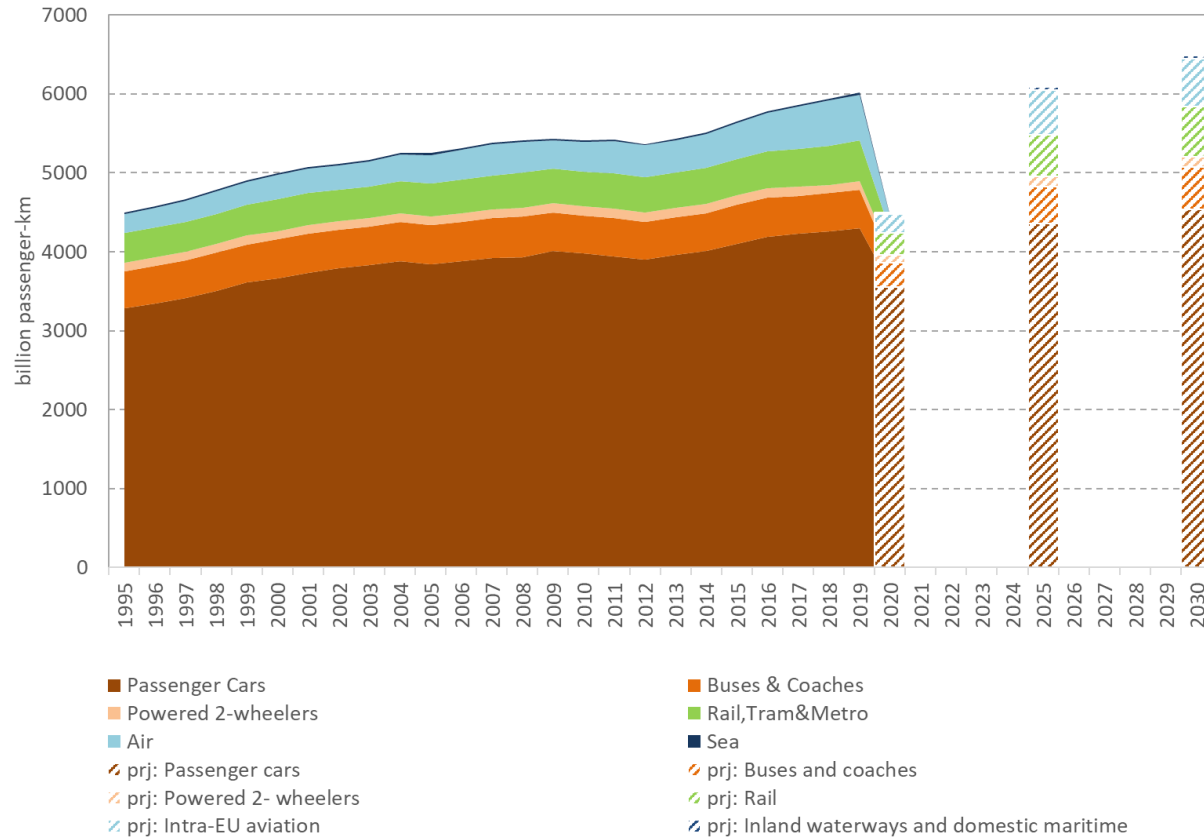

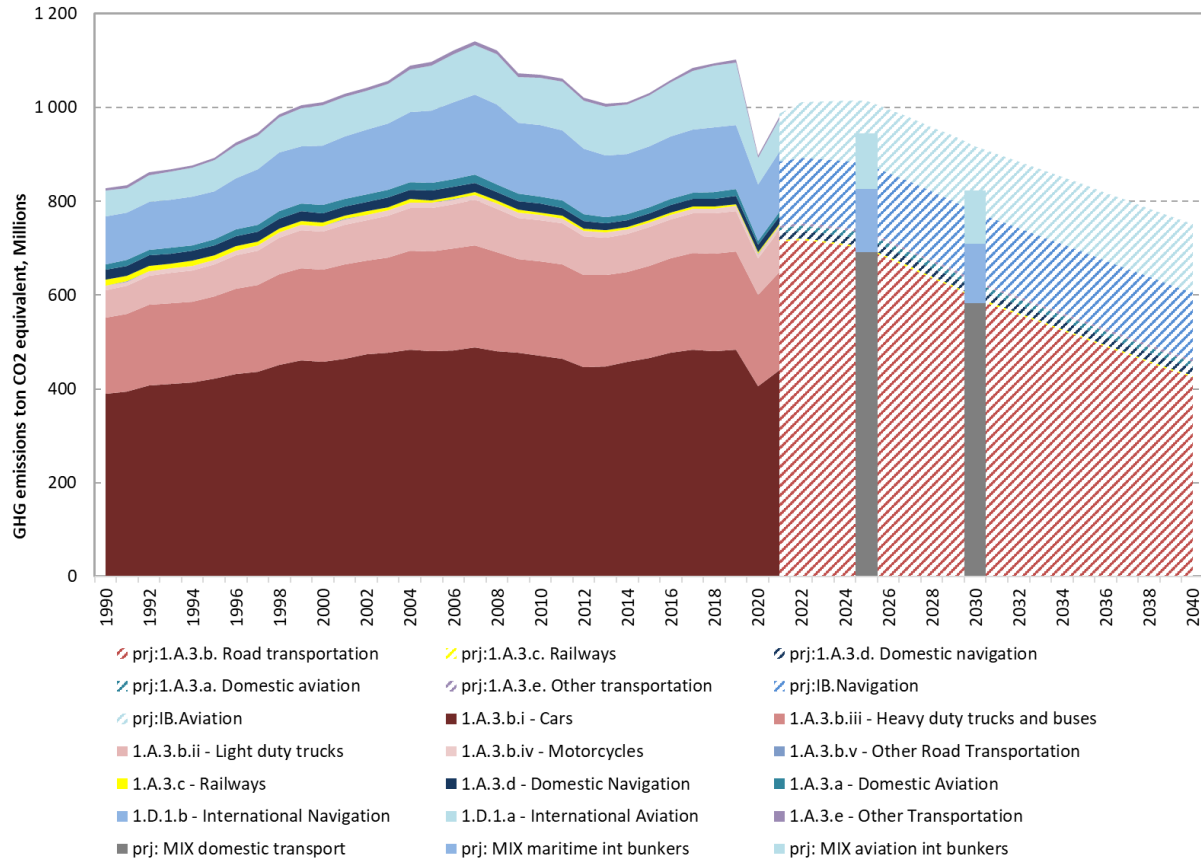

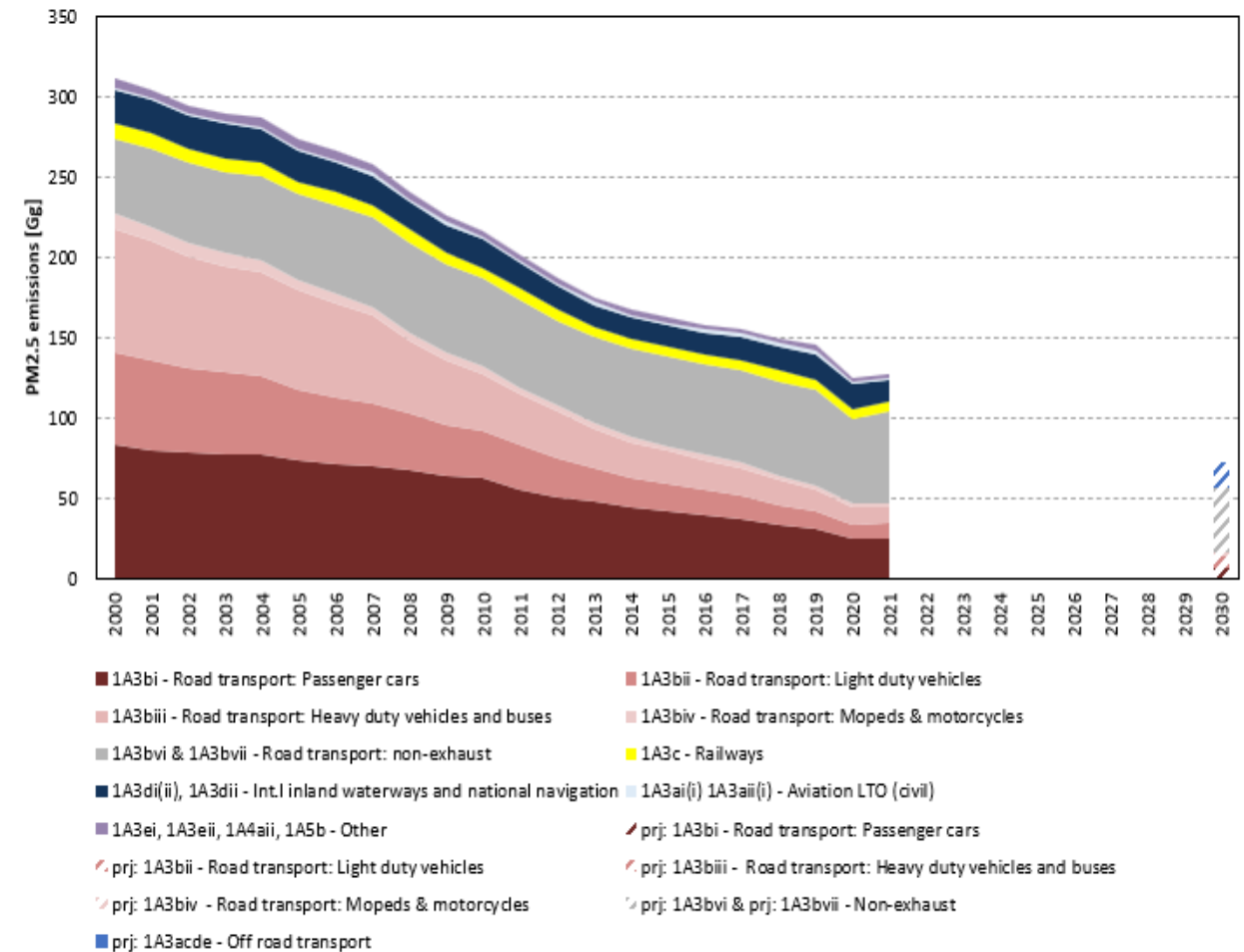


Demand is growing and it does not look like is going to stop
