- Local strategies

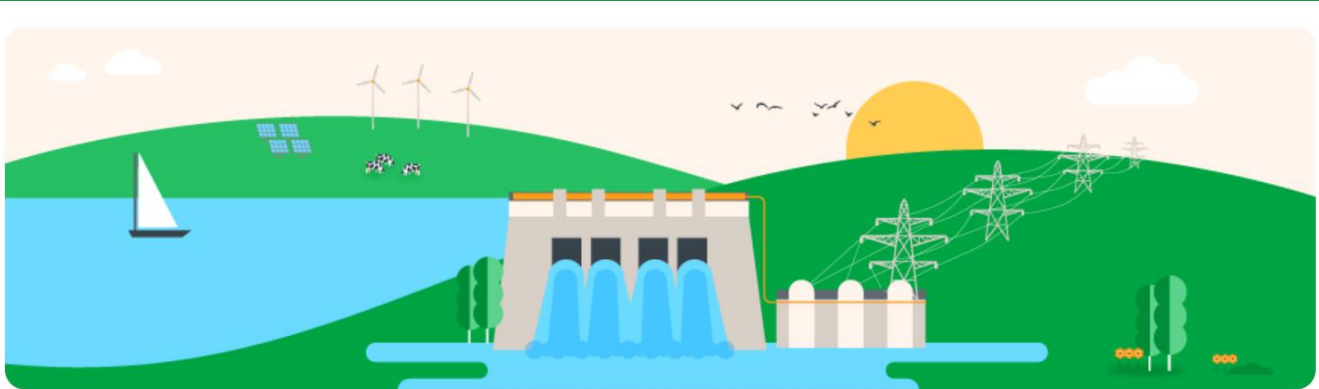


Transport is responsible for 1/3 of CO₂ emissions in Europe and is a major cause of air pollution in cities

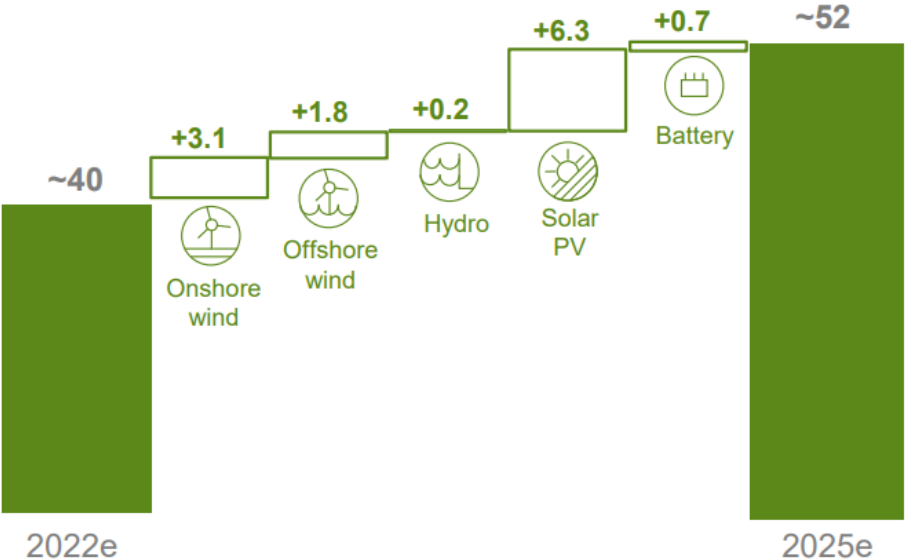


Go electric!
