- Ministers declaration June 2020 on international rail passenger transport
- European Commission workplan 2021 includes passenger rail action plan, October 2020;
- European Commission smart and sustainable mobility strategy on i.a. intermodality and 15 pilots new international rail passenger services, December 2020
- Kick off Year of Rail, sector statement on international rail passengers, 29/30 March 2021
- > Letter of Intent Trans Europe Express, mei 2021
- Progress Report platform international rail passengers presented to EU transport council 3 June 2021
- Council conclusions development of rail 3 June 2021 EC action plan, 14 December 2021
- > EC action plan international rail passenger, December 2021
- 2nd Progress report to EU Transport Council, 2 June 2022. Including sector statement
- 3rd progress report to EU transport council 1 June 2023. Including Sector statement

- Governments, infrastructure managers, involved in pilot coordination group
